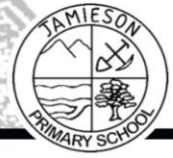
gear, so if you or someone you know has skis, boots, clothing etc. and would like to donate those to the school, we will gladly accept them.

Recycling. Thank you for the recycling materials that have been sent along to the school. These items have been turned into the latest "Space" projects. Keep the recyclables coming.



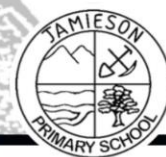

Dear Parents/Carers,

With the snow season commencing and Ski Chute 4 becoming extremely busy, we encourage you to take your child/children to Ski Chute 4 **ASAP** to avoid missing out on equipment, as they cannot hold any stock without knowing student sizes.

Please note the following: -

- a) The skis, poles (not for beginners), helmets and ski boots are the only equipment to be put on the Jamieson Primary School account, please. If needed, parents may like to look at separately purchasing snow pants, jackets and gloves for their child/ren whilst there or check out the Op Shops for great deals. School can also assist with sourcing snow gear for students, if required, and please let Genevieve know if this is the case.
- b) Can parents please assist staff to ensure correct sizing's for each item are recorded for their child/ren on the school spreadsheet at the shop's checkout.
- c) Please ensure each item of equipment is visibly marked with the correct size using permanent marker. School will provide named sticky labels for each child's equipment at school.
- d) Parents will need to take the equipment with them and drop it in to school for storage, please.
