Homework – We know that Reminder that all student's homework is to be handed in every Monday.

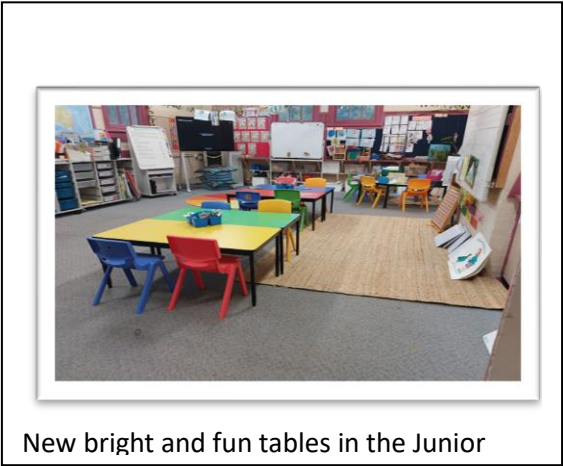
