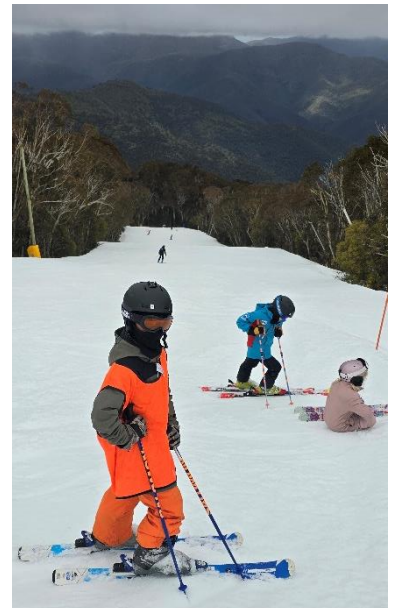


Athletics Day

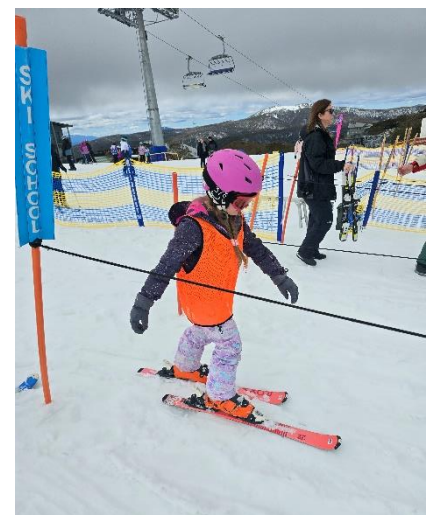

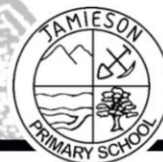


Skiing 2025

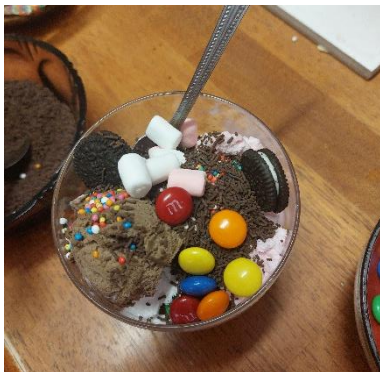
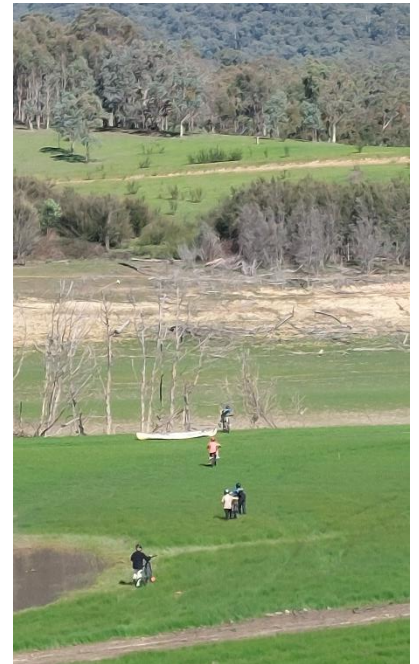


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Marble Day 2025
