PURPOSE

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Jamieson Primary School's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Jamieson Primary School's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- Foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- Support Jamieson Primary School's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities.
- Reduce student competition on the basis of clothing
- Enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community.

The School Council has developed a dress code that we believe provides a range of choices for students and is cost effective for families.

SCOPE

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE

Jamieson Primary School's school uniform items are as follows:

- Royal blue polo shirt embossed with the school logo.
(Short sleeved or Long sleeved)
Royal blue sports polo with the school logo (to be worn on sports day and sporting events)
- Grey or black trousers/track pants/shorts/leggings/skirts/skorts
- Royal blue polar fleece half-zip jacket with logo embossed.
- School Hoodie
- School summer dress available from the school uniform stock.

- Reversible bucket hat. Hats must be worn during sports and break times in Terms 1 and 4.

General appearance

While at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities, Jamieson Primary School students should make every effort to comply with the following:

- Uniforms be clean and in good repair
- Uniforms be clearly marked with the owner's name
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth.

Jewellery and cosmetics

Jamieson Primary School Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery to school. Stud earrings (preferably) and sleepers in the ears, and watches, are the only acceptable jewellery.

Unless there is a valid reason, cosmetics should not be worn at school. Clear nail polish is permitted.

Hair and Sun safety

Shoulder length or longer hair should be tied back to help restrict the spread of nits and lice and for student safety.

School uniform hats must be worn outside in Term 1 and Term 4 and on any other day prescribed by the school. School uniform hats may also be worn outside of this time period, by parent or student choice.

Hats are not to be worn inside.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet the Australian Standards 1067 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.

PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS

Uniform items can be purchased from Jamieson Primary at school.

Jamieson Primary School also offers second-hand uniforms for purchase.

Support for families experiencing difficulty assistance is provided by the school. Please contact the principal to discuss support that we may be able to provide to families experiencing difficulty meeting uniform costs.

Jamieson Primary School also has uniforms available to families to borrow on request.

IMPLEMENTATION

Jamieson Primary School will ensure that this Student Dress Code is communicated to all families and students through our website. We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible.
